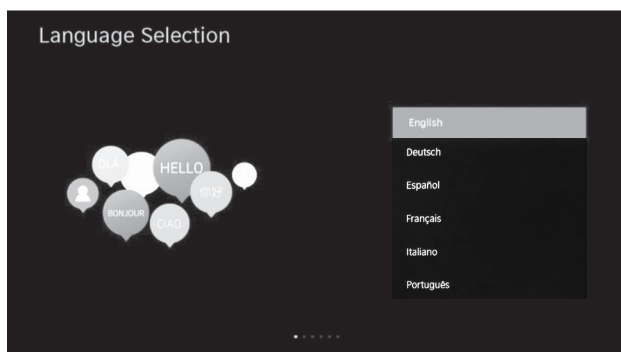

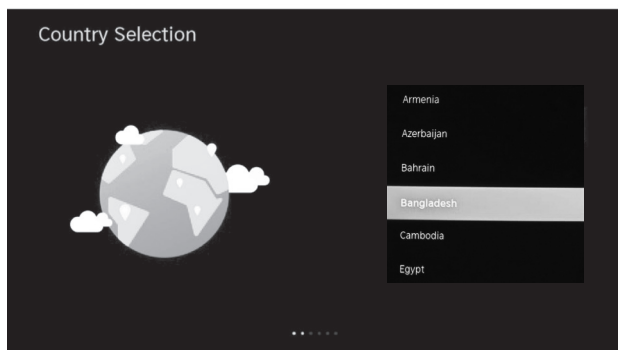
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Setup Wizard

Press **▼ / ▲** button to select the language and press OK button to turn to next page.



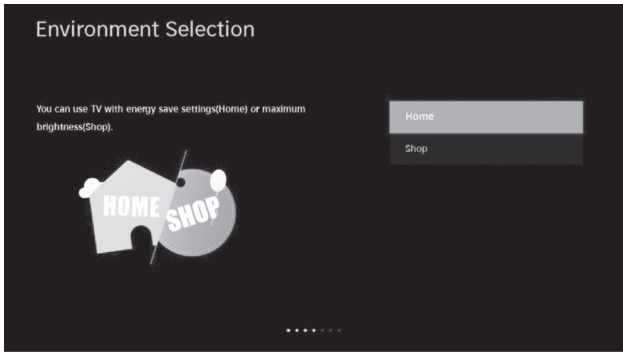
Press **▼ / ▲** button to select Country and press OK button to turn to next page..



Press **▼ / ▲** button to select Time Zone and press OK button to turn to next page.



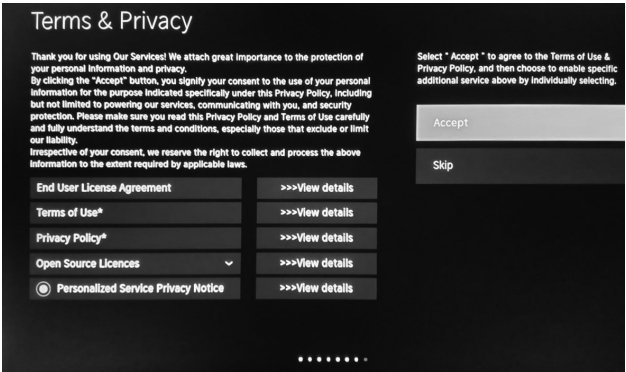

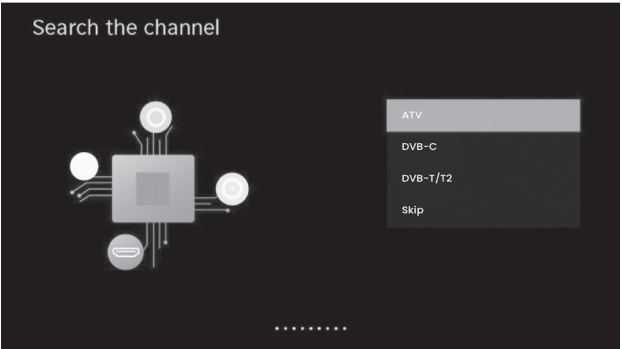

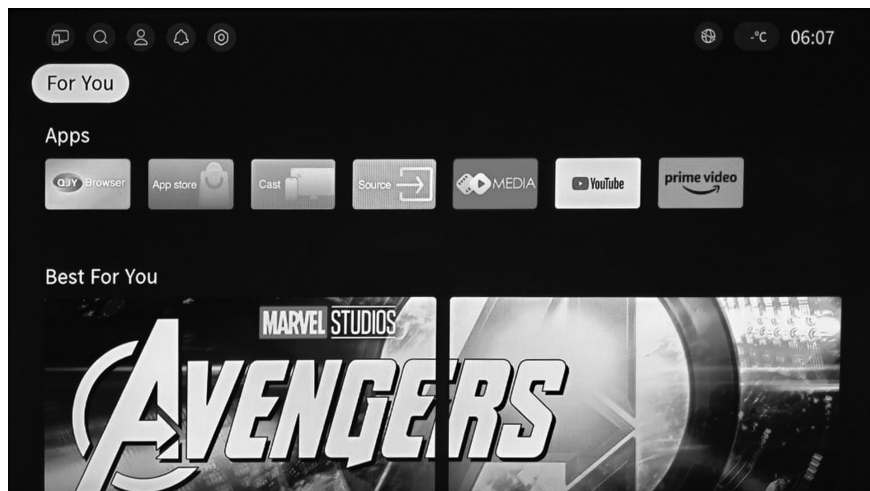

Press **OK** button to enter. Press **EXIT** button to quit.

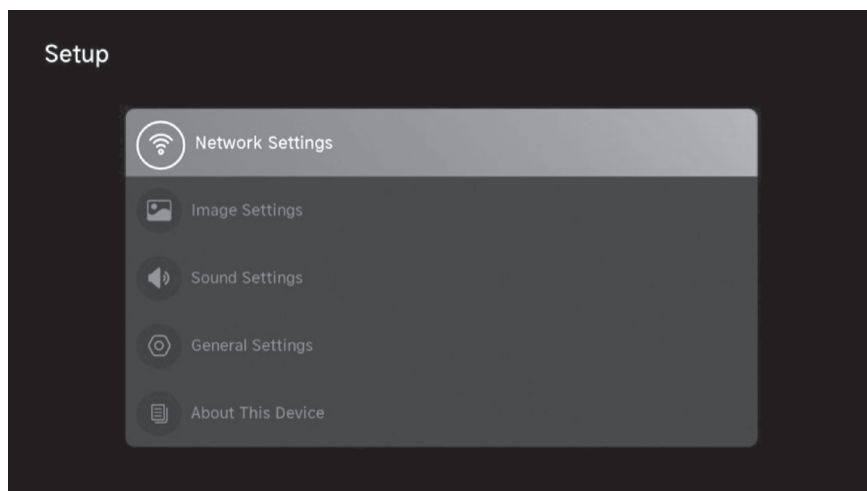


Setup

(Optional:Network Settings/Image Settings/Sound Settings/General Settings/About This Device)

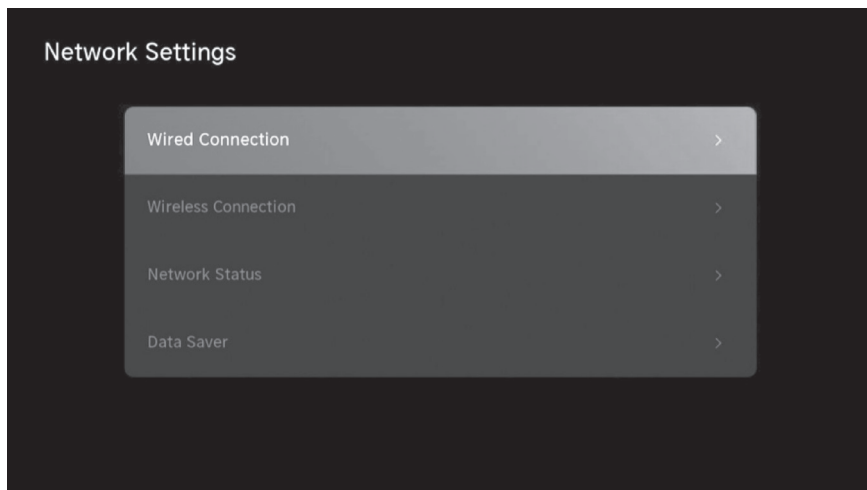


Network Settings

Press **OK** button to enter the sub-menu.

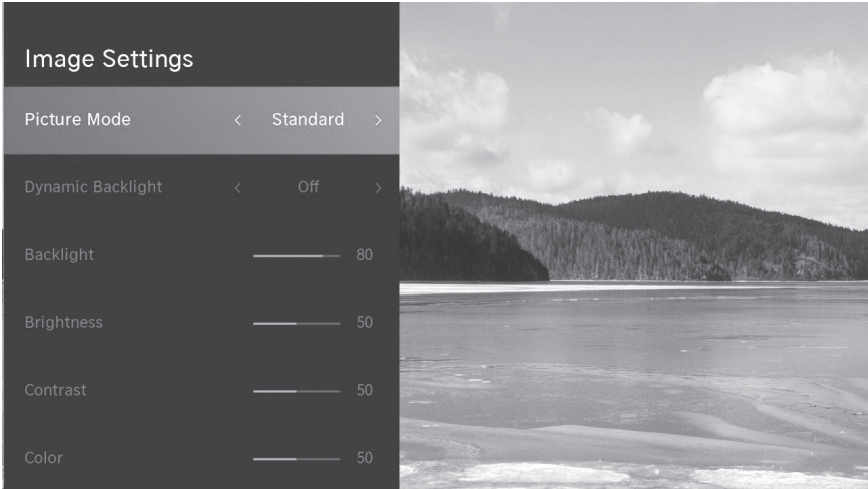


Press ▼ / ▲ button to select Wired Connection/Wireless Connection/Network Status/Data Saver.

Picture Mode

Highlight the item and press **OK** button to enter the sub-menu, that shows the picture mode you can choose.

Press **◀ / ▶** button to select Standard/Dynamic/Soft/Vivid/User.

- Standard** Produces a standard image.
- Vivid** Enhance the contrast, color and clarity of the screen to make the color more vivid.
- Eco** Reduce screen brightness, improved contrast for energy saving.
- Movie** This mode is more suitable for watching movies.
- Game** This mode is more suitable for playing games.
- Sport** This mode is more suitable for sport programs.
- User** Select to customize picture settings.

Dynamic Backlight

Press **▼ / ▲** button to select Dynamic Backlight and press **◀ / ▶** button to select On/Off

Backlight

- Press **▼ / ▲** button to select Backlight.
- Press **◀ / ▶** button to adjust.

Brightness/Contrast/Color/Tint/Sharpness

These terms are available only when "User" is selected in Picture Mode.

Press ▼ / ▲ button to select Contrast/Brightness/Color/Sharpness.

Press ◀ / ▶ button to adjust.

- Contrast Adjust the contrast of the image.
- Brightness Adjust the brightness of the image.
- Color Adjust the color intensity of the image.
- Sharpness Adjust the edge sharpness of the image.

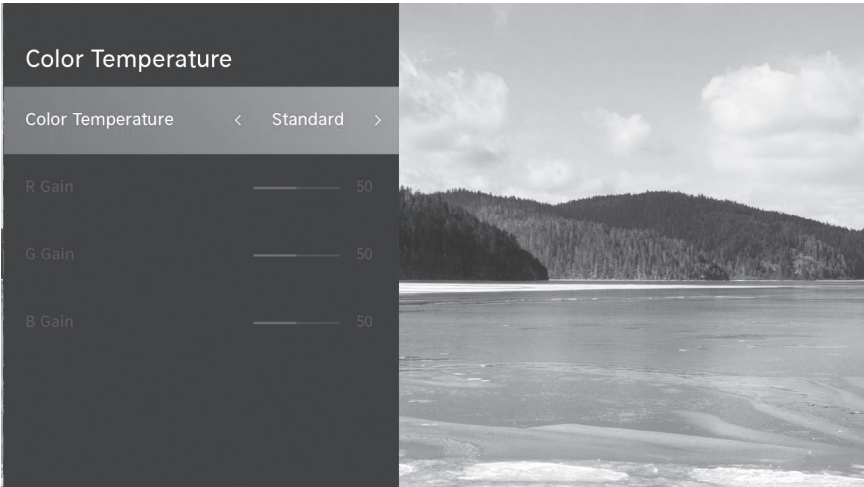
Color Temperature

Adjust the overall color of the image.

Press ▼ / ▲ button to select Color Temperature.

Press ◀ / ▶ button to select Standard/Warm/User/Cool.

- Standard The picture does not in favor of any color. The color is moderate.
- Warm The picture is in favor of red-green and less blue to make the color more vivid and soft.
- User Select to customize color temperature setting.
- Cool The picture is in favor of green-blue and less red.
 The whole color is in favor of light. The picture is more fresh and elegant.



R Gain/G Gain/B Gain

These terms are available only when "User" is selected in color temperature.

Press ▼ / ▲ button to select R Gain/G Gain/B Gain.

Press ◀ / ▶ button to adjust.

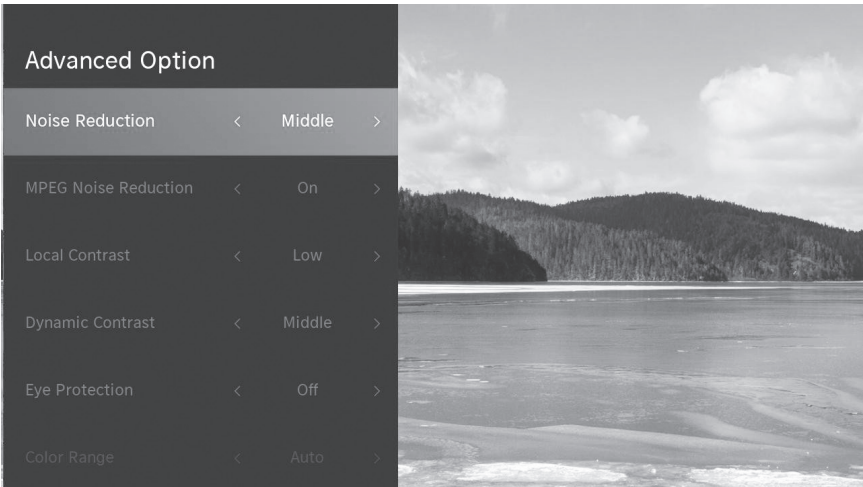
Aspect Ratio

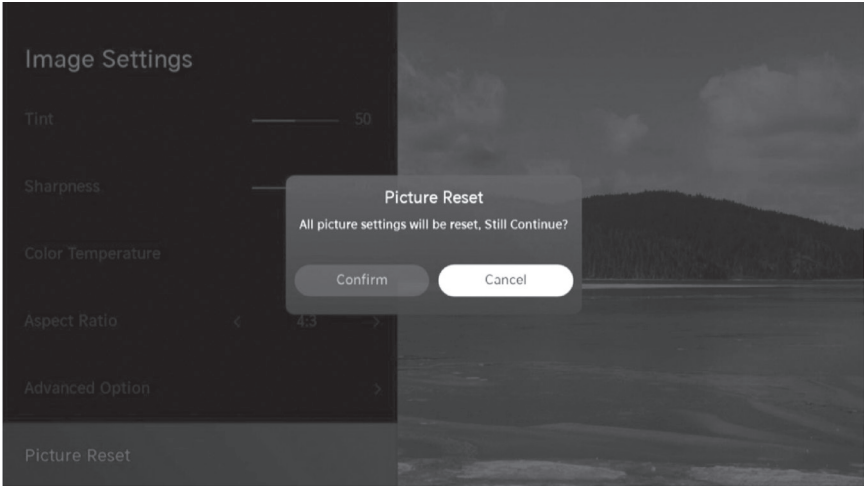

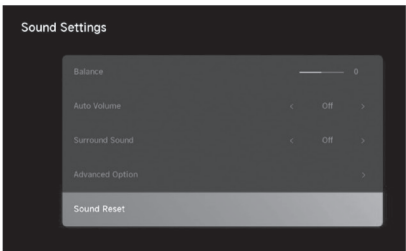
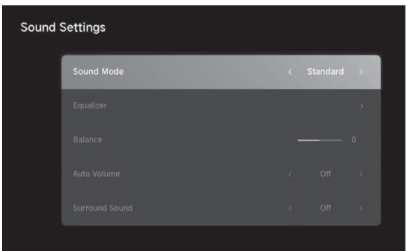

Balanced left and right channels.

Press ▼ / ▲ button to select Balance. Press ◀ / ▶ button to adjust.

Auto Volume

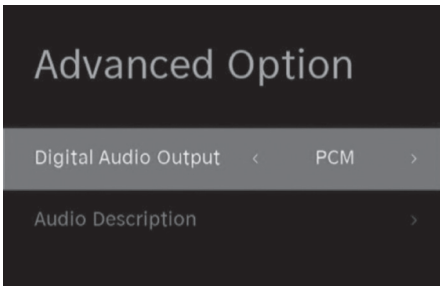
Press ▼ / ▲ button to select Auto Volume. Press ◀ / ▶ button to select On/Off.

Automatic Standby

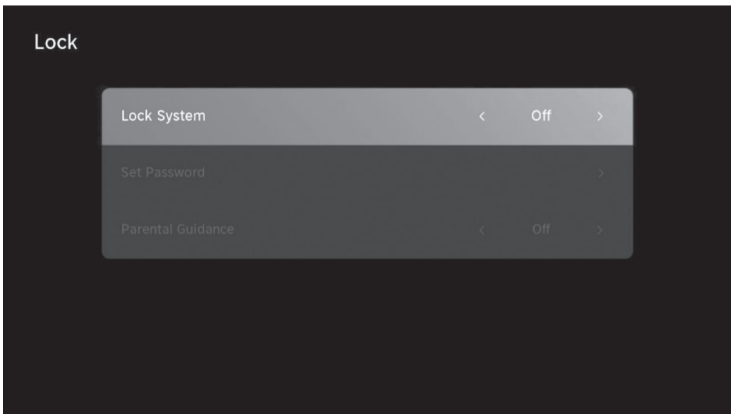
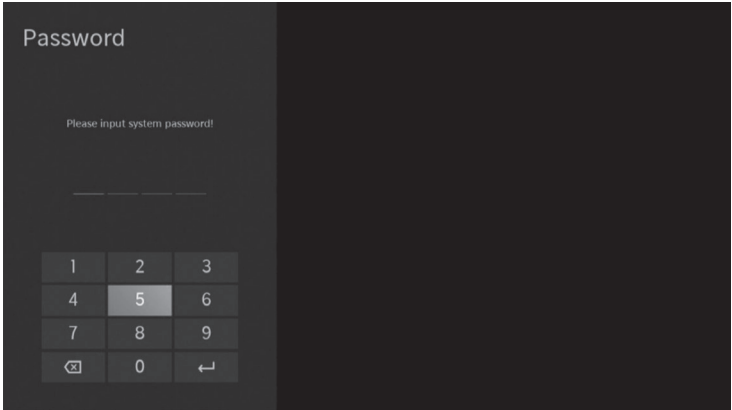
Press ▼ / ▲ button to select Automatic Standby. Press ◀ / ▶ button to select Off/4 Hours/ 6 Hours/8 Hours.

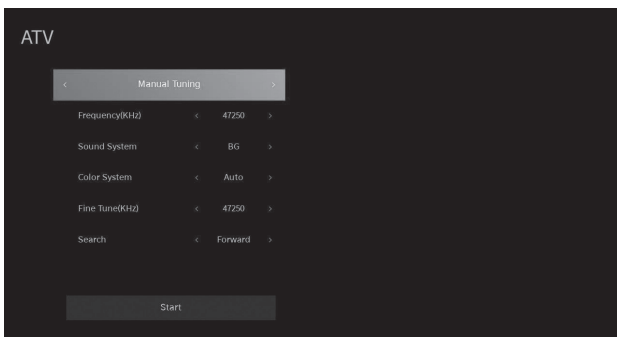
